Money Flows Like Water



TACIT == AUTOPILOT

Not conscious of using lower levels

Lose effectiveness of higher levels if you think about lower levels.

TRY IT!

- Think about each muscle contracting and relaxing when you walk
- Concentrate only on the sounds of syllables when you talk
- Focus on the machine's execution of your program the next time you code


